

2001 SENATE BILL 303

1 **AN ACT relating to:** a temporary emergency unemployment insurance program
2 and requiring the exercise of rule-making authority.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) If the 107th Congress of the United States enacts a temporary emergency
5 unemployment insurance program, the department of workforce development shall
6 promptly implement the program and shall promptly promulgate any
7 administrative rules that may be necessary to implement the program, to the extent
8 permitted by state law.

9 (2) If the 107th Congress of the United States fails to enact a temporary
10 emergency unemployment insurance program by January 1, 2002, the council on

1 unemployment insurance shall make a recommendation to the legislature, in the
2 manner provided under section 13.172 (2) of the statutes, concerning a Wisconsin
3 temporary emergency unemployment insurance program by January 31, 2002.
