Currently, the department of workforce development (DWD) administers the state unemployment insurance law, as well as the federal laws with which this state is required to comply in order to participate in the federal unemployment insurance program and to realize maximum advantage for this state from that participation. The council on unemployment insurance advises DWD and the legislature in carrying out the purposes of the law.

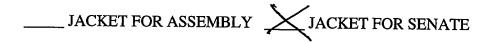
