1 346.57 (4) (b) 2. A school crossing guard is within a crosswalk at the 2 intersection or the other location or, if no crosswalk exists, is in the roadway at the 3 intersection or the other location.

3. A school crossing guard is placing in or removing from the roadway at or near
the intersection or the other location a temporary sign or device that guides, warns,
or regulates traffic.
