

**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2001 SENATE BILL 38**

October 2, 2001 – Offered by INSURANCE, TOURISM, AND TRANSPORTATION.

1 **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 346.57 (4) (b); and *to create* 346.57 (4) (b) 2.
2 and 3. of the statutes; **relating to:** the speed limit at certain intersections and
3 other locations marked with school crossing signs.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 346.57 (4) (b) of the statutes is renumbered 346.57 (4) (b) (intro.)
5 and amended to read:

6 346.57 (4) (b) (intro.) Fifteen miles per hour when passing an intersection or
7 other location properly marked with a “school crossing” sign of a type approved by
8 the department when children are any of the following conditions exist:

9 1. Any child is present.
