The Law Revision Committee met on Tuesday and voted to introduce DPI drafts LRB 1214/1 and LRB 1217/2. Could we get these two rolled into one bill for DPI? We will need to insert section notes later.

Also, they voted to introduce the following DRL drafts:

LRB 2821/p1  
LRB 2823/p1  
LRB 2833/p1  
LRB 2838/p1  
LRB 2856/p1

The committee also voted to introduce LRB 2834/p1, as amended by deleting Section 1. Could we have all 7 drafts rolled into one bill for DRL? Again, we'll have to insert section notes later.

The committee also asked that LRB 1198/p1 be broken down into smaller bills by subject matter for easier readability. Also, DRL explained that the sections relating to accountants were included in the budget, so may be deleted from 1198. The committee intends to take up 1198 at the next meeting (not scheduled yet).

According to the department of public instruction, the name of its "Libraries and Community Learning Division" was changed to the "Division for Libraries, Technology and Community Learning" in 1998.

Insert after Section 4: Sections 4 and 5 of this bill change the definition of "minority group pupil" in the minority group pupil scholarship program and special transfer program from "a pupil who is a Black American, a native American, a Spanish-surnamed American or an Oriental American" to "a pupil who is Black or African American, Hispanic, American Indian, an Alaskan native or a person of Asian or Pacific Island origin". According to the department of public instruction, the current definition of "minority pupil" is not consistent with the federal definition of race and ethnicity categories, and excludes individuals that may be identified as minority students.
