## ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 358

1	AN ACT to create 470.025 (12) and 470.03 (3) of the statutes; relating to:

	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
5	<b>SECTION 2.</b> 470.025 (12) of the statutes is created to read:
6	470.025 (12) A person engaged within this state in the practice of a profession,
7	other than professional geology, hydrology, or soil science, including archaeology,
8	aquatic biology, bacteriology, fish management, forestry, horticulture, limnology,
9	mycology, plant pathology, stream ecology, wetland science, or wildlife management,
10	where the practice of the profession by the person involves knowledge within the
11	range of professional geology, hydrology, or soil science, if the person meets all of the
12	following conditions:

1 (a) The practice of the profession by the person involves only the incidental 2 practice of professional geology, hydrology, or soil science. For purposes of this 3 paragraph, a practice of professional geology, hydrology, or soil science is incidental 4 to the practice of another profession if professional geology, hydrology, or soil science 5 is related to, but not the main purpose of, the other profession, or if a person engages 6 in a practice of professional geology, hydrology, or soil science while primarily 7 engaged in the practice of the other profession.

8 (b) The person does not designate himself or herself as a professional geologist, 9 hydrologist, or soil scientist or use any other title, letters, or designation which 10 represents or may tend to represent that the person is a professional geologist, 11 hydrologist, or soil scientist.

**SECTION 2m.** 470.03 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

13 470.03 (3) Upon the advice of the appropriate section of the examining board, 14 the examining board may promulgate rules that exempt a person who is engaged in 15 a profession related to those listed in s. 470.025 (12) (intro.) from the requirement 16 to obtain a license under this chapter if the practice of the profession by the person 17 involves only the incidental practice of geology, hydrology, or soil science, as defined 18 in s. 470.025 (12) (a), and the person does not designate himself or herself as a 19 professional geologist, hydrologist, or soil scientist or use any other title, letters, or 20 designation that represents or tends to represent that the person is a professional 21 geologist, hydrologist, or soil scientist.
