Section 1. Claim against the state. There is directed to be expended from the appropriation under section 20.395 (3) (eq) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1999 and 2001, \$9,296 in payment of a claim against the state made by Robert and Dorothy Messner, Brownsville, Wisconsin, as reimbursement for losses incurred in 1998 as the result of damage to the claimants' apple orchard caused by salt spray from STH 49, to which the department of transportation applied road salt. Acceptance of this payment releases this state and its officers, employees, and agents
