

2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 327

1 **AN ACT relating to:** expenditure of \$9,296 from moneys appropriated to the
2 department of transportation in payment of a claim against the state made by
3 Robert and Dorothy Messner.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1. Claim against the state.** There is directed to be expended from
5 the appropriation under section 20.395 (3) (eq) of the statutes, as affected by the acts
6 of 1999 and 2001, \$9,296 in payment of a claim against the state made by Robert and
7 Dorothy Messner, Brownsville, Wisconsin, as reimbursement for losses incurred in
8 1998 as the result of damage to the claimants' apple orchard caused by salt spray
9 from STH 49, to which the department of transportation applied road salt.
10 Acceptance of this payment releases this state and its officers, employees, and agents
