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2001 SENATE BILL 356

December 19, 2001 – Introduced by Senators ROBSON, ERPENBACH and ROESSLER, cosponsored by Representatives JOHNSRUD, LA FAVE, J. LEHMAN, MILLER, OTT, PLOUFFE, POCAN and TURNER. Referred to Committee on Human Services and Aging.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Wisconsin has adopted the Nurse Licensure Compact, which requires the member states to participate in the coordinated licensure information system. The system is a cooperative effort by the member states to create a coordinated data base of all licensed registered nurses and licensed practical nurses, all disciplinary actions taken against licensed nurses, and all denials of nurse licensure. However, current law prohibits the department of regulation and licensing and the board of nursing from disclosing the name, social security number, telephone number, or street address of any licensee who informs the department or the board that he or she does not want such information disclosed. This bill allows the department and the board to disclose such information about licensed nurses and about persons whose applications for nurse licensure were denied to the coordinated licensure information system.
