Please draft legislation converting the funding source for 2.0 FTE warden positions in the DNR from the snowmobile account to the tribal gaming account.

The total number of authorized wardens is to remain the same. The excess snowmobile funds would remain in the respective account. The change is permanent, as opposed to one-time funding.

2 enforcement of laws regulating snowmobiles and the operation of snowmobiles

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of natural resources receives funding for conservation warden positions relating to enforcing the laws that regulate snowmobiles and the operation of snowmobiles from Indian gaming receipts that are deposited in the general fund and appropriated to the department of administration and from the snowmobile account of the conservation fund. The snowmobile account mainly consists of snowmobile fuel tax revenues and revenues from snowmobile registration fees. Almost all of these revenues are used for snowmobile trail aids and snowmobile law enforcement and safety training. This bill transfers the funding source for two conservation wardens from the snowmobile account in the conservation fund to the revenues from Indian gaming.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
