1 AN ACT *to amend* 453.06 (2m) (b) and 453.06 (2m) (c) of the statutes; **relating**
2 **to:** veterinary postgraduate training permits.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 453.06 (2m) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 453.06 (2m) (b) Upon application, the examining board may grant a veterinary
5 postgraduate training permit to a person undertaking intern or resident training at
6 a school of veterinary medicine in this state. ~~The applicant shall submit evidence~~
7 ~~that the applicant has successfully completed the national board examination and~~
8 ~~the clinical competency test, is scheduled to take the national board examination and~~
9 ~~clinical competency test for the first time, or is awaiting results on the national board~~
10 ~~examination and clinical competency test.~~ The only purpose of the veterinary

1 postgraduate training permit is to provide opportunities in this state for the
2 postgraduate education of persons who have received the degree of doctor of
3 veterinary medicine or an equivalent degree but who have not yet met the
4 requirements for licensure in this state. Issuance of a postgraduate training permit
5 does not modify in any respect the requirements for licensure to practice veterinary
6 medicine in this state, and a permittee permit holder may practice veterinary
7 medicine on privately owned animals only within the scope of the permittee's permit
8 holder's internship or residency program. Violation of this restriction or of any
9 applicable provision of this chapter constitutes cause for revocation of the permit.

10 **SECTION 2.** 453.06 (2m) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

11 453.06 **(2m)** (c) A license issued under this subsection expires upon
12 termination of the licensee's employment at a school of veterinary medicine in this
13 state. A postgraduate training permit expires upon termination of the permittee's
14 permit holder's internship or residency program, ~~upon the permittee's failure to take~~
15 ~~the national board examination or the clinical competency test as scheduled, or upon~~
16 ~~notification to the permittee that he or she has failed to successfully complete either~~
17 ~~the national board examination or the clinical competency test.~~
