1 AN ACT *to amend* 227.19 (2) of the statutes; **relating to:** notification to the
2 legislature of a proposed rule.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 227.19 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 227.19 (2) NOTIFICATION OF LEGISLATURE. An agency shall submit a notice to the
5 presiding officer of each house of the legislature when a proposed rule is in final draft
6 form. The notice shall be submitted in triplicate and shall be accompanied by a report
7 in the form specified under sub. (3). A notice received under this subsection on or
8 after ~~November~~ September 1 of an even-numbered year shall be considered received
9 on the first day of the next regular session of the legislature. Each presiding officer
10 shall, within 7 working days following the day on which the notice and report are

1 received, refer them to one committee, which may be either a standing committee or
2 a joint legislative committee created by law, except the joint committee for review of
3 administrative rules. The agency shall submit to the revisor for publication in the
4 register a statement that a proposed rule has been submitted to the presiding officer
5 of each house of the legislature. Each presiding officer shall enter a similar
6 statement in the journal of his or her house.
