*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3             **SECTION 1.** 60.71 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:  
4             60.71 (2) (b) One or more of the petitioners shall verify that the petition was  
5             signed personally by the persons whose signatures appear on the petition, or a  
6             person who signs a petition may have his or her signature notarized. The petition  
7             is presumed to have been signed by the persons whose signatures appear on the  
8             petition. No petition with the requisite number of valid signatures may be declared  
9             void because of alleged defects in the information required to be included in the

1 petition. The town board at any time may permit a petition to be amended to conform  
2 to the facts.
