TO 2001 SENATE BILL 61**

January 24, 2002 – Offered by Representatives HUNDERTMARK and MUSSER.

1 **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 120.13 (37); and *to create* 120.13 (37) (c) of
2 the statutes; **relating to:** awarding high school diplomas to veterans.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 120.13 (37) of the statutes, as affected by 2001 Wisconsin Act 38,
4 is renumbered 120.13 (37) (a) (intro.) and amended to read:

5 120.13 (37) (a) (intro.) Notwithstanding s. 118.33 (1), award a high school
6 diploma to a person who is meets all of the following requirements:

7 1. Is at least 65 years old, attended.

8 2. Attended high school in the school district, left or attended high school in this
9 state and resides in the school district.

10 3. Left high school before receiving a high school diploma to join the U.S. armed
11 forces during a war period under s. 45.35 (5) (e), and served.
