

**SENATE AMENDMENT 6,
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE BILL 1**

May 15, 2002 – Offered by Senator BRESKE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 4, line 10: delete lines 10 to 21 and substitute:

3 **“29.335 Feeding wild animals for nonhunting purposes. (1)** In this
4 section, “affected deer management area” means a deer management area in which
5 a disease that affects wild animals has been discovered or a deer management area
6 that adjoins a deer management area in which such a disease has been discovered.

7 **(2)** The department shall promulgate rules to regulate the recreational and
8 supplemental feeding of wild animals in affected deer management areas for
9 purposes other than hunting. Any rules promulgated under this subsection do not
10 apply after August 31, 2007, unless the standing committee for natural resources
11 matters of each house of the legislature, as designated by each presiding officer,
12 determines by majority vote, on or before August 31, 2007, that in order to control

1 the spread of disease in wild animals this subsection shall continue to apply after
2 August 31, 2007. If the standing committees make this determination, the
3 chairperson of each of these standing committees shall promptly notify the revisor
4 of statutes of the committee's determination. Upon receipt of such notification, the
5 revisor shall publish a copy of the notification in the Wisconsin Administrative
6 Register.

7 (3) In promulgating rules that limit the amount of bait or scented material
8 which may be placed for the recreational or supplemental feeding of wild animals for
9 purposes other than hunting and that apply to land located outside affected deer
10 management areas, the department may not require that the amount of bait
11 material or liquid scent that is to be placed be less than 10 gallons in a baited area.”.
