Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This legislation permits local governing bodies to appoint reserve election inspectors to work at the polls on Election Day. These reserve inspectors are not subject to the residency and nomination restrictions that apply to the initial selection of election inspectors. This increases the number of individuals who can assist at the polling place. A municipality may have increased costs if it uses more poll workers. Currently it is difficult to get enough individuals to serve as election inspectors.
