Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires the Legislative Audit Bureau to conduct a performance evaluation of the Educational Services Program for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing in the 2004-2005 fiscal year. It directs that the audit report be distributed to appropriate standing committees by June 30, 2005. The audit can be accommodated within current agency operations.
