Subject Petition requirements for the creation of a town sanitary district		

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill is not likely to have a fiscal effect on local governments. Currently, land owners are allowed to petition a town to establish a town sanitary district, with the requirement that one or more of the petitioners verifies that the petition was signed personally by the persons whose signatures appear on the petition. The bill adds the option of having a signature notarized instead of having a signature verified by the petitioner. The petitioner is responsible for obtaining a notarization.
