Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits manufacturing, distributing, delivering or possessing with intent to manufacture, distribute or deliver the controlled substance 4-MTA or flatliner and creates a felony penalty. The bill also increases the penalties for several other controlled substance violations.

It is impossible to predict the increase in workload for the circuit courts because the number of offenses involved is unknown and whether the increased penalties will cause more defendants to contest their cases. Additional contested litigation would require more judge, court reporter and court staff time. These costs are borne by both the state and the county. The additional revenue that would be collected from fines is also unknown. The state retains 90% of these fines while the county retains 10%.
