Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The proposed legislation affects the University of Wisconsin System relative to the development of a Job Training Access Policy. This requires every public educational institution to establish a policy regarding access to its facilities by local organizations and businesses for employment-related training. If the institution permits access, based on available space, appropriateness of training and consistency with institutional mission, it may set reasonable fees for this access. There should be no fiscal impact to comply with this legislation.
