Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would require employers to permit their employees to display the U.S. flag and prohibits employers from discriminating against an employee who has displayed a U.S. flag or has otherwise engaged in a related protected activity. Employees of the State of Wisconsin who feel their rights under the bill had been violated could seek enforcement of those rights by filing a complaint with the Personnel Commission. Employees of other employers in Wisconsin would initiate their enforcement proceedings with the Department of Workforce Development.

This estimate only addresses the fiscal consequences on the Personnel Commission of the enforcement procedure before the Commission. The estimate does not reflect the costs to state agencies associated with defending the claims permitted by the bill.

The Commission assumes that the number of complaints filed would approximate the number of claims now filed under that portion of the Wisconsin Fair Employment Act (subch. II, ch. 111, Wis. Stats.) prohibiting discrimination for use or nonuse of lawful products.

During the 4 year period from 1997 through 2000, 8 of the 836 complaints filed with and processed by the Commission included claims alleging discrimination for use or nonuse of lawful products. All of those 8 cases included claims of other forms of discrimination/retaliation, such as age or sex.

The Commission assumes there would be no more than 2 additional cases filed with the Commission annually due to the language in the bill. Existing staff would be able to absorb this nominal estimated increase in caseload without additional expenditures.
