**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Under this bill, the parent may request a law enforcement agency in the jurisdiction in which the other parent is present to assist in locating and returning the child. A law enforcement agency shall assist in locating and returning the child of a parent who makes a request under this section if the parent provides the law enforcement agency with a certified copy of the order that is allegedly being violated by the other parent.

To accomplish this, local law enforcement will have to shift priorities in order to comply with this directive and it may cause local law enforcement agencies to redeploy their workforce. According to one local law enforcement agency, a case such as this, may take up to 6-8 hours and require the officer to confirm with the courts the appropriate child support order. Whether this redeployment requires additional staff is not determined.
