Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB 708 would require telecommunications providers to make certain notifications to residential customers when charges for telephone calls exceeds \$500 during a billing period.

AB 708 would also require the Public Service Commission (PSC) to develop rules to set forth procedures for telecommunications providers and customers to resove disputes over service for intrastate telephone calls including disputes over charges for access numbers to Internet service providers.

The PSC would absorb the cost of the rule-making process using existing staff and managing the case load of the agency as needed.
