Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill expands the definition of "peeping tom" offenses and requires a person convicted or adjudicated to register as a sex offender. The bill also permits a juvenile adjudicated under these provisions to petition the court to expunge their record.

It is impossible to predict the number of additional cases that will be brought into circuit court or the number of expunction petitions that will be filed. It is expected that any additional litigation will have to be absorbed by existing court staff. The additional judge, court reporter and court staff costs are borne by both the state and the county.
