Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB 822 requires anyone under 14 to wear a helmet while riding their bicycle or being transported by bicycle. It requires that DMV keep a record of warnings issued for 1st violations. 2nd violation yields a \$30 forfeiture. There is no record keeing requirement for these.

CONCLUSION:

\$25,270 One-time cost to modify DMV Violation System allowing inclusion of warnings for first-time bicycle helmet violations on DMV driving record system.

Indeterminable ongoing revenue increase from forfeitures for violations.

Indeterminable ongoing cost increase for DMV processors to create a "Non-driver" records for these offenders.

No local costs.

BASIS FOR CONCLUSION:

35 days @ \$722 per day = \$25,270 for computer programmer time and system use costs.

Any forfeitures collected will result in revenue through the normal citation/forfeiture revenue stream.

Most potential violators of this proposed law do not hold a driver license or state ID card. In nearly all cases, DMV will have to create a new customer entity on the driver licensing system to allow capture and display of these warnings.

Local law enforcement agencies already correspond with parents on a regular basis. This proposal would just create a new violation type requiring this interaction.
