Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would permit a district attorney to file a petition in circuit court to enjoin violations of certain anti-fireworks laws. This ability already exists for cities, towns and villages represented by those municipalities' attorneys. There is no information by which to estimate whether this proposed change would actually shift any of the current filing to the DA office. As DA offices have discretion as to whether or not to accept this work, it is likely that there would be only a minimal increase, if any at all, in the workload of DA offices were this bill to be enacted.


