#### **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill imposes new duties on the Department of Regulation and Licensing. These duties include the state disciplinary process that applies to licensed and certified health care professionals as defined under the proposed legislation.

The proposed legislation includes all "health care professionals", which means as many as 100,000 credential holders are potentially affected. If between 1/2 and 1% of these credential holders are checked annually, 500 health care professionals would be subject to review by the agency.

The fiscal impact to the agency would be significant. There would be a need for additional staff to carry out the responsibilities stated in the bill. There would also be additional supplies and services costs to support these staff and perform other functions such as printing and mailing.

The revenues estimated are the total cost needed to implement the duties outlined in the bill. These costs would be passed along to credential holders and increase the cost of the Initial credential fee and the renewal fee for credentials.
