Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

LRB 1399/1 requires health insurance plans, including health insurance plans provided by the state, to offer coverage for mental health conditions, if it is offered, on a par coverage offered for physical conditions.

The bill makes this coverage a prohibited subject of collective bargaining for state labor contracts under ch. 111.91, Wis. Stats.

This bill would have no fiscal effect on the Department of Employment Relations (DER).

DER has no information to project the fiscal effect of this legislation on local governments.
