Providing health insurance coverage of mental disorders that is the same as coverage of physical conditions

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

LRB 1399/1 prohibits all group health policies offered by the State to its employees and annuitants and to participating local governments from including limitations on mental health or alcohol or other drug abuse treatment (AODA) that are not applied to other medical services. This proposal will have a fiscal effect to the extent that it increases premium paid by the State and participating local governments for health insurance coverage.

Currently, due to the federal Mental Health Parity Act (MHPA), the state health program adheres to most of the requirements of LRB 1399/1. Under the MHPA, the annual dollar limits for mental health services under the State health insurance program have been temporarily suspended since 1998. However, an annual maximum of 30-days is applied to inpatient mental health treatment. In addition, the program currently limits annual coverage for AODA to \$6,300 for inpatient services, \$1,800 for outpatient services and \$2,700 for transitional services.

The impact of LRB 1399/1 on the State health insurance program would be to:

- * Permanently remove the annual dollar maximums (currently suspended) for mental health services.
- * Remove all annual dollar maximums for AODA treatment.
- * Remove the annual 30-day inpatient limit for mental health and AODA services.

The federal Mental Health Parity Act includes an exemption if the cost of parity exceeds 1% of the program's costs. For this reason, the effect of the federal MHPA is being studied to determine whether it has increased health plan costs by 1% or more. LRB 1399/1 does not include such an exemption. Therefore, the cost of LRB 1399/1 will vary, depending upon whether it is determined that the federal MHPA does not apply to the state program.

According to information provided by the consulting actuary to the Group Insurance Board, the estimated fiscal impact of LRB 1399/1 could range from \$461,600 annually (\$.25 per member per month x 157,000 members x 12 months x .98 the state's share of the cost) if the health plans remain subject to the MHPA, to a minimum of \$3.87 million (\$2.10 per member per month x 157,000 members x 12 months x .98) if MHPA does not apply.

Impact on Funding: \$461,600 = \$212,300 GPR/\$249,300 all other funds \$3.87 million = \$1.78 million GPR/\$2.09 million all other funds On-going.
