Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill mandates health insurance providers to cover mental and nervous disorders, alcoholism and other drug abuse conditions the same as the coverage for the treatment of physical conditions the same as the coverage for the treatment of physical conditions.
