**Bill Summary:**


This bill requires that when a vehicle is using its windshield wiper system, the headlamps must also be in use. Exceptions are made for when the wipers are only being used to clean the windshield, on vehicles with automatically activated headlamps, and when exempted on authorized vehicles.

**Fiscal Estimate:**

There will be minor, immeasurable fiscal impacts on DNR law enforcement, as this will require additional time when a citation is issued. Due to the fact that law enforcement officers may not stop a vehicle solely to determine compliance with this statute, any citations issued would likely be in conjunction with others being issued at the same time.


