Bill Summary

The bill allows municipalities to create a local park and recreation district that would act as a separate local unit of government with authority to acquire, develop, maintain, improve, operate, and manage recreational facilities and programs. The district would be eligible for Stewardship Local Assistance Program grants.

Fiscal Estimate:

The ability of local jurisdictions to create park districts has no fiscal impact on the department's administration of the Stewardship Local Assistance Programs.
