### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill specifies rest and meal periods for employees.

The Personnel Commission has authority under ss. 111.375(2) and 230.45(1)(b), Stats., to hear complaints filed under the Wisconsin Fair Employment Act (subch. II, ch. 111, Stats.), against the State of Wisconsin as an employer. This authority includes processing complaints alleging retaliation for having engaged in certain protected activities, such as for having exercised a right relating to hours of labor.

Few, if any, complaints have been filed with the Personnel Commission under the existing provisions relating to hours of labor.

The Commission assumes that the bill would result in the filing of no more than 2 additional complaints with the Personnel Commission. Existing staff would be able to absorb this nominal estimated increase in caseload without additional expenditures.

This estimate only addresses the fiscal consequences on the Personnel Commission of the enforcement procedure before the Commission. The estimate does not reflect the costs to state agencies associated with defending the claims permitted by the bill.
