Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill increases Wisconsin retirement system (WRS) benefits for all shool district employees who are not teachers, librarians or administrators. No state agency or organization representing school districts or school administrators collects data that would allow the formulation of a reasonable estimate as to how many persons would be covered by this bill.

In addition, the bill would increase WRS benefits for individuals based upon their number of hours worked for a school district and their final average salary. There is currently no data with which to estimate these numbers.
