Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill broadens the threat statute to include the threat of use of a biological agent. This proposal will allow prosecutors greater discretion to charge this offense or other current law options when confronted with such a situation. This proposal may serve as a deterrent and may reduce local law enforcement's response costs.
