



2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 665

December 3, 2001 - Introduced by Representatives PETTIS, MUSSER, KRAWCZYK, BIES, OLSEN and TOWNSEND, cosponsored by Senator HARSDF. Referred to Committee on Tourism and Recreation.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 346.94 (15) of the statutes; **relating to:** allowing certain school
2 buses to tow trailers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no person may operate a school bus with a trailer or semitrailer attached. This bill allows the operation of a school bus with a trailer or semitrailer attached if the school bus is equipped with a side emergency exit door or side emergency exit windows.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 346.94 (15) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 346.94 (15) TOWING BY BUSES OR HUMAN SERVICE VEHICLES. No person may
5 operate a school bus or a human service vehicle over any public highway of this state
6 with any trailer or semitrailer attached. This subsection does not apply to a school
7 bus equipped with a side emergency exit door or side emergency exit windows.

8 **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**
