



## 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 98

February 6, 2001 - Introduced by Representatives WOOD, POWERS, GRONEMUS, MUSSER, GROTHMAN, KEDZIE, GUNDERSON, LASSA and OTT. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources.

1     **AN ACT** *to amend* 167.31 (2) (d); and *to create* 167.31 (4) (g) of the statutes;  
2           **relating to:** fishing with a bow and arrow near a roadway.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, with certain exceptions, no person may shoot an arrow from a bow from or across a highway or within 50 feet of the center of a roadway. This bill permits a person who is fishing with a bow and arrow to shoot an arrow from a bow within 50 feet of the center of a roadway if the person does not shoot the arrow from the roadway or across a highway.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3           **SECTION 1.** 167.31 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:  
4           167.31 (2) (d) Except as provided in sub. (4) (a), (cg) ~~and~~, (e), and (g), no person  
5           may discharge a firearm or shoot a bolt or an arrow from a bow or crossbow from or  
6           across a highway or within 50 feet of the center of a roadway.  
7           **SECTION 2.** 167.31 (4) (g) of the statutes is created to read:
