



## 2001 SENATE BILL 190

May 23, 2001 - Introduced by Senators BRESKE, WELCH, S. FITZGERALD, GEORGE, SCHULTZ and A. LASEE, cosponsored by Representatives WADE, KRAWCZYK, OWENS, SKINDRUD, VRAKAS, BIES and MCCORMICK. Referred to Committee on Education.

1     **AN ACT to repeal** 118.045 (3); and **to amend** 118.045 (1) of the statutes; **relating**  
2     **to:** the commencement of the school term.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Current law prohibits a school district from beginning the school term until September 1 unless the school board holds a public hearing on the issue and adopts a resolution to that effect. This bill eliminates this exception.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3     **SECTION 1.** 118.045 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:  
4     118.045 (1) Except as provided in subs. sub. (2) and (3), beginning in the year  
5     2000, no public school may commence the school term until September 1.  
6     **SECTION 2.** 118.045 (3) of the statutes is repealed.  
7     **SECTION 3. Initial applicability.**
