



2001 SENATE BILL 339

December 6, 2001 - Introduced by Senators HANSEN, WIRCH, BAUMGART, BURKE, SCHULTZ and ROESSLER, cosponsored by Representatives PLOUFF, OTT, STARZYK, KRUG, LASSA, TURNER, J. LEHMAN, SKINDRUD, RYBA, HAHN, MUSSER, URBAN, ALBERS, HUBER, SYKORA, HINES, BERCEAU, MCCORMICK and SCHOOFF. Referred to Committee on Labor and Agriculture.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 118.12 (4) of the statutes; **relating to:** exclusive contracts for
2 the sale of soft drinks in schools.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, if a school board enters into a contract that grants to one vendor the exclusive right to sell soft drinks in one or more schools of the school district, the school board must ensure that milk is available to pupils in each school covered by the contract whenever and wherever the soft drinks are available to pupils.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 118.12 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

4 118.12 (4) If a school board enters into a contract that grants to one vendor the
5 exclusive right to sell soft drinks in one or more schools of the school district, the
6 school board shall ensure that milk is available to pupils in each school covered by
7 the contract whenever and wherever the soft drinks are available to pupils.
