**Proposed rules relating to aid to families with dependent children  
Chapter DWD 11  
CR 01-099**

**Need for rules**

The objective of the rule is to repeal chapter DWD 11, relating to the Aid to Families with Dependent Children program. The AFDC program has been replaced by Wisconsin Works, ss. 49.141 to 49.161, Stats., and ch. DWD 12.

The Department of Health and Family Services has consented to repeal of this rule chapter. Although the determination of Medicaid eligibility remains connected to AFDC and s. 49.19, Stats., Medicaid statutes and rules do not refer to ch. DWD 11.

**Public hearing response**

A public hearing was held in Madison on September 28, 2001. No comments were received. James Emerson, Policy Director of the Assembly Republican Caucus, appeared for information only.

**Response to Legislative Council staff recommendations**

The references to Chapter DWD 11 that are found in Chapter DWD 12 will be repealed with other upcoming changes to Chapter DWD 12.

**Final regulatory flexibility analysis**

The proposed rule does not affect small business as defined in s. 227.14, Stats.

Chapter DWD 11  
Aid to Families with Dependent Children

**Statute interpreted:** s. 49.19, Stats.

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**Rule Text**

SECTION 1. Chapter DWD 11 is repealed.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.

Although the proposed rule only appears to repeal ch. DWD 11, it is noted that current s. DWD 12.09 (2) (n) (intro.) refers to s. DWD 11.19 (2) and (2m). The department should review whether the repeal of ch. DWD 11 necessitates an amendment to s. DWD 12.09 (2) (n) (intro.) to correct the reference to what will be a repealed provision.
