

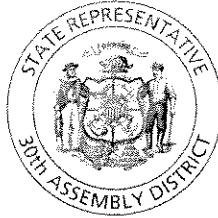

AB 650 – Yes

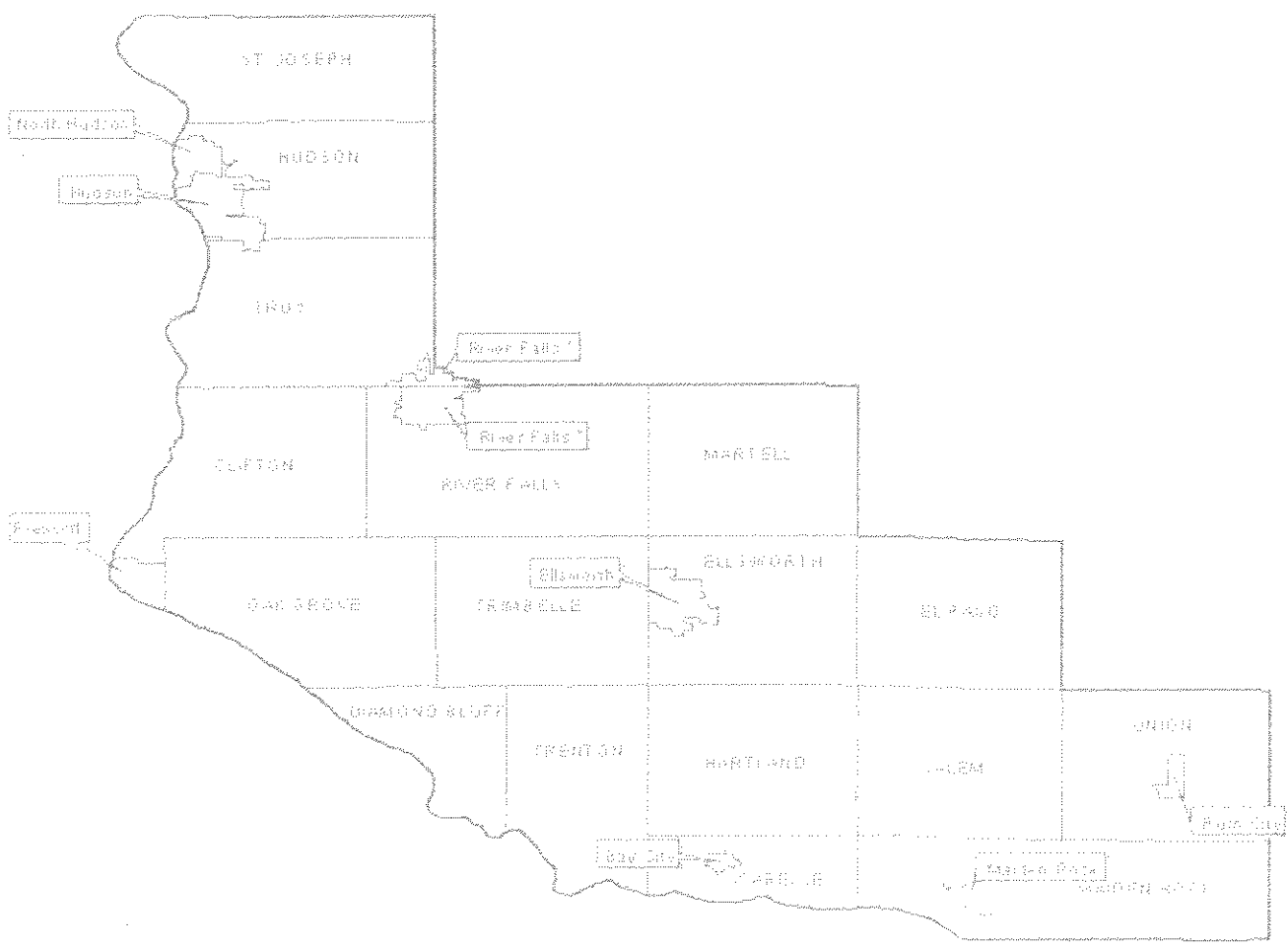

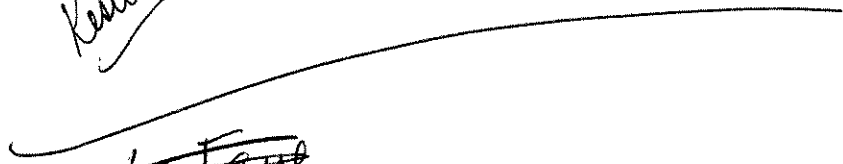
