

**Testimony Before the Joint Committee
for the Review of Administrative Rules
Senate Bill 116**

April 24, 2001

Thank you Co-chairs Robson and Grothman and members of the committee for holding a public hearing on Senate Bill 116. I introduced this legislation to ensure that permanent, administrative rules receive the full attention of the legislature after they are submitted by state agencies to standing committees of the legislature. The bill would change the submission deadline for rules from November 1 to September 1 of even numbered years.

Under current law, if an agency submits the final draft of a proposed rule to the legislature after November 1 of an even-numbered year, the notice is considered received on the first day of the next regular session. Because of this deadline, the legislature often receives a considerable number of rules in mid to late October of even numbered years, when many legislators are in their districts working on reelection campaigns. Moving the submission deadline to September 1 gives the legislature ample time to consider administrative rules.
