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TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. VE 7.06 (14) is amended to read:

VE 7.06 (14) Failure of the veterinarian to advise the client that the person assisting is a veterinary student or an unlicensed assistant.

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The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.22 (2) (intro.), Stats.
