Dear Senator Robson,

I'm writing in response to some disturbing news I've recently heard regarding your upcoming hearing on the extension of the Baiting and Feeding ban for whitetail deer. I understand that you have come under considerable pressure to reverse this extremely important and beneficial ruling. I want to make sure you know the reasons why the vast majority of individuals and sportsman's groups in this state have completely supported our DNR in this regard.

1. Disease Transmission: I'm sure you've heard from many people (that want baiting and feeding to be allowed) that "there is no scientific evidence linking a feeding site to the transmission of CWD". However, there is strong anecdotal evidence indicating it is quite possible to transmit CWD through saliva, urine or feces in a confined area but for now, that is a true statement. We just do not know exactly how it is transmitted. However, that isn't the point ! We know of at least a half a dozen other diseases that are ABSOLUTELY PROVEN to spread more rapidly at a feeding site...even one with as little as 2 gallons of corn!!! Obviously, the best example of this is the terrible epidemic of Bovine TB in Michigan where baiting and feeding by the truckload was common practice until that state realized that ARTIFICIAL CONCENTRATIONS OF GAME ANIMALS IS ASKING FOR TROUBLE.

As a reality check, please make an effort to speak with a farmer in your district and ask him or her what makes up their yearly vaccination schedule for their cattle. You'll find that they vaccinate every animal, whether they need it or not, at least 2 times per year as a preventative measure. They have to do it because their animals are constantly in close proximity to one another and cannot afford to let "one bad apple spoil the bushel". Really just common sense don't you think? Also please realize that wild deer are not really any different than cattle at all when they are subjected to a regularly replenished, high energy food source.....as many as possible crowd the site to feed until the food is gone. This does not happen in the wild because a natural food source is not constantly replenished in the same spot day after week after month. Think about the sanitary conditions of some of these feeding sites after being used by dozens of deer for months at a time. It's appalling!!!!

2. Overpopulation: As a public official, I'm sure you've had occasion to

deal with the insurance companies on their concerns regarding the rising incidence and costs associated with deer / car collisions. I'm sure you've also heard of the people that have been severely injured or even killed in these tragic accidents. Those statistics as well as those from our professional game managers in the DNR are telling us that our herd is just way out of control from a population standpoint. One of the reasons for this is the hundreds of thousands of tons of artificial energy (ie: corn, carrots, apples...etc) we dump into our forests every year. Its been estimated that one 100 car train can carry approximately 1 million pounds of corn....last year we dumped 12 of those trains in the woods north of state highway 64. My point is that all of this feed unnaturally increases the carrying capacity of the land. When that food source disappears, the overpopulated herd is forced to move more to find a "natural" meal that gets more and more difficult to find as the population rises. The other thing we need to remember here is that by feeding deer, we aren't allowing nature to control the population based on what the environment can support.

Where there is plentiful food the reproductive rate increases - even when the environment as a whole can't support that population without supplemental feeding. You see, it's a Catch 22.....More artificial feed equals more deer equals less space/food for each equals habitat destruction. I think Aldo Leopold said something like this back in the 1930's by the way.

3. Societal / ethical issues: First, allow me to be blunt. The future of hunting in this state and every other state depends primarily on the non-hunting public attitudes....it always has and always will. I challenge you to speak with 10 non-hunters and ask them the following question: "Do you support the practice of dumping a pile of food on the ground as a means to lure deer for harvest?" I guarantee that at least 8 of those ten will say absolutely no!! My points here are that you don't need a pile of corn to harvest a deer (or 5) and that our continued broad public support is extremely conditional in nature. I and most of the hunters in this state do not want to be perceived by the general public as slobs that shoot helpless "cattle" with their nose in a feed pile. I think baiting gives that perception....that we are all about the kill instead of the things that really matter like family, friends, and tradition.

It's hard at best to talk about the ethical implications of baiting and feeding given the diversity of hunters in Wisconsin but I will say that since baiting has become so popular in the last 10 years or so, the quality of the experience for me and most of the people I have spoken with has decreased dramatically. The incidence of conflicts or outright arguments in the field (public and private) are increasing every year! Baiting and feeding breeds unhealthy competition between neighbors and territorial disputes / baiting wars are the result. A food pile, in effect, designates the deer in a given area as "my deer" and people get terribly protective of it. Baiting, in my opinion, has somewhat reduced the tradition of hunting deer into nothing more than another form of instant gratification....not unlike video games and credit cards. You put in minimal effort for maximum or guaranteed success. It shouldn't be that way!!!

Thank you so much for taking the time out of your day to read this. I don't necessarily expect you to agree with all of my points but I do hope you take them into consideration when you are making your decision on NR 10 & 45. The DNR has taken a bold step in eliminating baiting and feeding of deer that will yield positive results for generations of hunters and deer in Wisconsin. Please don't undo that step on November 7th.



Dear legislators in the great state of Wisconsin,

I understand that the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules (JCRAR) will be meeting Thursday, November 7, 2002 in the State Capitol to discuss the extension of the above referenced rules as requested by the WDNR for the purposes of assisting in the control of CWD. I am a Wisconsin resident, northwoods property owner, and an avid deer hunter.

I strongly encourage your support for the extension of these rules which will allow for the extension of the deer baiting and feeding bans.

Please don't be fooled by the argument that the deer kill is down because baiting is not allowed. The kill is down because of a general public concern over the long term consequences of CWD and how it could potentially impact humans. All the individuals I know that are deciding not to hunt this year are doing so because their spouses simply do not want venison in the household or consumed by their children, until their comfort levels in eating venison are restored.

Articles through the press have obviously changed peoples views on the health concerns of eating venison and have blown the health risks way out of proportion. The re-establishment of baiting and feeding will not subdue the public's fear of eating venison, and continued feeding and baiting will only continue to congregate deer into small areas further increasing the percentage of deer contact between infected animals.

We need to allow the deer baiting and feeding ban ample time to work and potentially confirm the claim that deer sightings by hunters are actually increasing due to less nocturnal movement patterns. Early bow season and T Zone reports by hunters afield, including myself and my 13 year old son, appear to support this claim.

The kill is down because hunters are logging less time afield, not because it has been more difficult to shoot deer. More liberal hunting opportunities in the form of more available tags and hunting days are far better alternatives to increasing the kill.

Finally, how could this state respectfully ask for federal funds to fight CWD if we are not formulating and implementing state policies and programs which will reduce deer contact at feeding locations. The re-establishment of baiting and feeding practices would appear, to me, to be very hypocritical. Let's not put Wisconsin in that position, and let's not put our treasured deer hunting heritage at further risk!

Once again, I ask you to please support the WDNR's request to extend these rules beyond the current November 30th deadline. I thank you in advance for your support.

Subject: BAITING AND FEEDING BAN



Senator,

Please pass my comment on to the Legislative Joint Committee on Review of Administrative Rules concerning extending emergency rules related to controlling CWD.

I have always been opposed to "baiting" of any wildlife for the purpose of killing them. I do however, support the right to recreational and supplementary feed wildlife on my property. I have been feeding for over 20 years and have several video tapes of various wildlife to prove it.

I would suggest the following: Ban baiting altogether, much like laws dating back approx. 20 years ago. Also, you could only feed up to one week before the gun deer season when all left over feed or salt blocks had to be removed. After the season, feeding could be resumed. Stiffen fines and confiscate property of "cabin shooters" much like weapons and vehicles are confiscated for violations involving them now.

I feel this is a compromise to this controversial issue. I was shocked years ago when the DNR liberalized the laws allowing baiting in the first place. I do not believe responsible feeding contributes to disease as I have never seen a sick deer on my property. Regardless what we artificially do to try to control diseases, they are naturally spread through natural contact, mating for instance.

Please present the above to the appropriate people. I am asking for your support in what I believe is a compromise solution that would be accepted by many.
