Class A bear hunting licenses

The Problem

There currently exists an inequity in the state's eligibility requirements for applying for a Class A bear hunting permit.

A young person who has not reached the age of 12 cannot apply for a Class A bear hunting license even if this person will be 12 years old by hunting season.

The Solution

Senate Bill 66 will correct this by allowing an eleven year old to apply for a permit and receive a preference point as long as he or she turns 12 years old and has passed a hunters safety course by the first day of bear hunting season.

Senate Bill 66 is the companion bill to Rep. Gunderson's Assembly Bill 31.

Bipartisan Support

Senate Bill 66 is authored and sponsored by both Republicans and Democrats.

Please recommend SB 66 for passage by the full senate.
