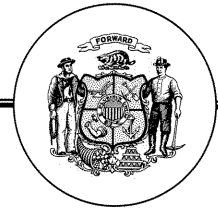

I respectfully ask that you hold a public hearing and executive session on Assembly Bill 199, relating to vehicle owner liability for violations of certain traffic laws relating to railroad crossings and providing penalties.

AB199 passed the Assembly Committee on Highway Safety unanimously in May and the full Assembly by an overwhelmingly bi-partisan vote of 94-2 in October, after which it was sent to your committee.

Again I respectfully request you take action on AB199 as soon as possible before session ends. Taking action on AB199 would be a step in strengthening efforts to improve railroad crossing safety.
