Dear Senator Breske:

The Senate Committee on Insurance, Tourism, and Transportation will be hearing Assembly Bill 519 today. I regret that another committee meeting prevents me from testifying before you on this bill. I hope that you will accept this letter in my place, and allow me to present some words on its behalf.

AB 519 would designate the 1-43 bridge over the Fox River as the Leo Frigo Memorial Bridge. Leo was a resident of De Pere who, after achieving great success with the Frigo Cheese Corporation, dedicated his life to help those less fortunate than himself. He opened Paul's Pantry in 1983 to collect and deliver food to the poor of the Green Bay area. Leo continued his service ~~his service~~ up until the moment of his untimely death this past February. He died in a car crash while delivering to a disabled and needy friend.

The naming of a bridge for this humanitarian is not a partisan issue; recognizing generosity and selflessness never should be. My colleagues in the Assembly noted this when AB 519 unanimously passed the Transportation Committee and with one dissenting vote in our house. I have no doubt that your committee and the full Senate will also recognize the honor that Leo Frigo has earned.
