I would like to urge you to support Senate Bill 241 and would be happy to discuss this issue with you if you have any questions or comments.

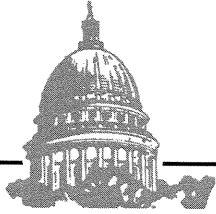
