Hi, Vaughn and Beth: Thanks to Roger for signing on to SB 274. As you recall, this is the same as Roger's bill last session that went through the steps perfectly, until it died on the Assembly calendar the last day of the session. We tried to get it into the DOT remedial bill this session, but the Law Revision Committee had some reservations that it was a bit more than purely remedial.

I believe this again should be bi-partisan and non-controversial. We and WATDA jointly asked for the penalty increase a couple of sessions ago, and what we found was the classic "unintended consequence" -- since the penalty is now a fine the violation becomes a crime, and we've found that district attorneys, who admittedly have far more serious crimes to prosecute than acting as a dealer without a license, just ignore the violation. We are thus in the position of asking that the penalty be made a forfeiture instead of a fine.

I just wanted to ask, if you would consider scheduling it for a hearing sooner rather than later. We are most interested in getting this through and I'm looking at the session ending in May (or March). I'm copying Tami for her information, as the bill would come there after Senate action. Thank you very much for listening!
