CALLING FOR A COUNTY WIDE REFERENDUM ON WHETHER THE  
STATE OF WISCONSIN SHOULD ENACT COMPREHENSIVE  
CAMPAIGN FINANCE REFORM

1 WHEREAS, Wisconsin must preserve its long tradition of clean and open government; and

2  
3 WHEREAS, campaign spending is spiraling out of control and special interest groups are  
4 playing an increasingly dominant role in financing elections and referenda; and

5  
6 WHEREAS, voter participation is declining and fewer people are willing to run for public  
7 office because of the high cost of campaigns; and

8  
9 WHEREAS, the special interests that finance campaigns now enjoy disproportionate access to  
10 public officials at key times in the legislative process allowing for undue influence over public policy  
11 decisions; and

12  
13 WHEREAS, Wisconsin's current public finance system is severely underfunded and is  
14 providing only very small grants which neither give candidates incentive to accept spending limits nor  
15 relieve them of the obligation to raise funds from powerful special interests; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, the current system lacks adequate contribution limits and reporting requirements to  
18 keep special interest in check; and

19  
20 WHEREAS, without campaign finance reform that ensure public policy decisions will be  
21 determined on the merits of the issues, not the size of campaign contributions, the future of Wisconsin  
22 government is at risk.

23  
24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly  
25 assembled this 10<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2000, that the following referendum be placed on the November  
26 2000 election ballot:

28 "Do you support legislation to reform the state campaign finance system that would limit  
29 campaign spending, require stricter contribution limits and require full and prompt disclosure of  
30 election-related activities?"

32 AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be sent to Governor Tommy  
33 G. Thompson, Senators and Representatives representing all or a portion of our county, and the  
34 Wisconsin Counties Association.

5. Rooms must be reserved by the Friday of the week prior to the meeting. Users of meeting rooms must complete an agreement and set-up sheet by the Friday prior to the meeting.
6. Daily rental fees are \$12.00 for the Eau Claire Room and \$6.00 for the Chippewa Room and Red Cedar Room. All fees are due at the time of reservation. Organizations or individuals who are delinquent in paying their meeting room fees may not reserve a room until all fees are paid. There is no refund for cancellations.
7. The user of a meeting room agrees to abide by the copyright laws and regulations of the United States, and agrees to defend, indemnify and hold the library harmless from liabilities which may arise as a result of violations of the copyright laws or regulations.

- 8. The library is not responsible for loss or damage to materials belonging to organizations or individuals using the meeting rooms. Organizations may be assessed charges if damage results from their use of the rooms.
